

Mexico: next inroad for MNRI?

Polish schools/clinics receive Presidential award

One of the articles in SMEI's recent book, Reflexes: Portal to Neurodevelopment and Learning was a series of stories written by 3 therapists (Agata Palasz, Paulina Turzynska, Michalina Lelek) of the Kashubian Foundation for the Rehabilitation of the Disabled in Poland. They provide MNRI® therapy at three Schools for

Rehabilitation, Education, and Early Childhood Development. Under the supervision of the Director Wieslawa Gorecka, there are about 100 pupils with a variety of developmental challenges including multiple and profound disabilities. Working with these children are 24 therapists, teachers, speech therapists, and psychologists.

The article followed 4 children: Nadia, Paulina, Krzysztof, and Zosia. These children suffered from neurodeficits such as autism, Rett Syndrome, congenital encephalocele, and complications of being severely premature. The success of MNRI® with each of these children was huge and allowed their natural personalities to bloom!

Ms. Gorecka, herself the mother of a child with a disability, overcame incredible odds to create these 3 schools, each in a rural area of Poland.

Ms. Gorecka brought in classes for MNRI® training for the therapists of her schools in 2002 with Dr. Masgutova and immediately saw fairly quick improvements compared with other therapies. Today, all her school teachers and therapists are trained in basic MNRI® programs.

The work of Ms. Gorecka in re-building the three schools is amazing.

Parents of the children support and love her immensely for her big heart, devotion, and being an advocate for their children. They also love her because she does not give up on the children; she believes their symptoms still can be improved, not just supported in the current state. She chose the MNRI® tools and they give it 3-4 hours a day for each child and 2-3 hours of academic programming in art, music, and activities addressing perception and cognitive processes. Their MNRI Mentor and Instructor, Malgorzata Koczyk has led them since the school doors opened, teaching classes and consulting with the professionals. What an amazing job Ms. Gorecka has done!

This year, Ms. Gorecka was given an award for her unique results with children and for her organizational work in founding the schools by Polish President Bronislaw Komorowski!


One of the stories in the book, Reflexes: Portal to Neurodevelopment and Learning is a brave and fascinating article written by Kim Masters of Minneapolis, MN. Kim suffered from a severe Eating Disorder for much of her adult life and was hospitalized at In-Patient Treatment Programs for it more than once. Eating Disorders can also undermine a person's self confidence and feelings of self-worth as they struggle to control actions they cannot stop.

In her compelling narrative, Kim tells how she never "felt right in her own skin" but this symptom was not addressed until, at yet another In-Patient Treatment Program, she was treated by a Speech Therapist for Reflex Integration. As her reflexes improved, she also was able to forgive herself for behavior that she now realized was only her body's way of protecting herself.

There is little effective treatment for Eating Disorders so this story represents new and uncharted waters for the disorder. Kim's articulate and fascinating account helps us all understand ourselves and our bodies a little better.
